***Alex Martinez to be inducted into the
York County Soccer Hall of Fame Class of 2022.***

York County, SC—The York County Soccer Hall of Fame announced today Alex Martinez has been selected to the class of 2022, which will be officially inducted into the Hall of Fame on August 25, 2022.

Martinez is one of the most decorated male soccer players to come out of York County. He grew up playing for Discoveries Soccer Club, played high school at Northwestern, went on to play collegiately for High Point University and NC State University and extended his career in MLS with Sporting KC and USL side Charlotte Independence.

While playing for Discoveries he helped guide the team to state and regional championships and in 2009 the team won the National Championship. He also helped Northwestern to multiple state championships and the Trojans were crowned National Champions in 2009 by ESPNrise.

The Montevideo, Uruguay native was not only a formidable player on the pitch but has also been a successful coach and developer of youth talent. He has coached teams for Discoveries, CISC, Charlotte Soccer Academy, and with the MLS expansion side Charlotte FC.

The York County Soccer Hall of Fame will hold it's dinner and induction ceremony Thursday, August 25 at the Courtyard Marriott at Kingsley in Ft. Mill, SC. There will be a cocktail hour starting at 6:00 PM followed by dinner at 6:45 with hall of fame induction speeches and Teams of Distinction recognition starting around 7:30 PM.
